



Creating your Unique Student Identifier (USI)

As of January 2015 all students completing nationally recognised training need to have a USI (Unique Student Identifier). It is a reference number that records your training in a secure online record. You are able to access a complete accurate list of your achievements from any VET (Vocational Education Training) organisation in the one secure location that you can access at anytime from anywhere.

Create your USI

1. Please make sure you have one form of ID from the list below ready.

Examples of acceptable forms of ID:

- Medicare Card
- Driver's Licence
- Australian Passport
- Non-Australian Passport (with Australian Visa) for international students
- Birth Certificate (Australian) *please note a Birth Certificate extract is not sufficient
- Certificate Of Registration By Descent
- Citizenship Certificate
- ImmiCard

Important: The details you enter MUST match the details shown on your form of ID

2. Open this webpage <http://www.usi.gov.au>
3. Click on Student Entry
4. Click on Create USI
5. Read through the information and click on continue.
6. There is a page here which you need to tick regarding agreeing to terms and conditions.
7. Again click Create USI.
8. Enter your details and follow prompts.
9. Remember to **write down your password**
10. Remember to **write down your secret questions and the answers**
11. **Write down your USI.**
12. Enter your USI on your enrolment form and return it with payment to Milpara Community House PO BOX 136, email milpara@dcsi.net.au
